
FOSTERING GLOBAL CONNECTIONS: EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING IN NATURE CONSERVATION

ABSTRACT

The "Building a Sustainable World Together: Global Dialogues for Nature Conservation and Education" programme exemplifies experiential learning to engage student teachers, in-service teachers, teacher educators, and communities in addressing environmental challenges through Education for Sustainable Development (ESD). The programme includes interactive workshops and dialogue sessions that develop intercultural communicative competence and skills for facilitating global dialogues.

Participants engage in two local dialogue sessions on nature conservation education, followed by three global Zoom sessions with peers, conservation practitioners, and educators from regions such as England, France, Ireland, Macau, the Philippines, and Thailand. The global dialogues address key topics: (1) "Planning, Experimenting, and Reflecting (PER) for ESD," focusing on personal growth in ESD practices; (2) "ESD Curricula for Nature Conservation," exploring local and global curricular approaches; and (3) "ESD Pedagogical Design," fostering collaborative teaching strategies.

The programme connects participants with organisations like The Nature Conservancy and Hong Kong Wetland Park for hands-on learning, enriching their

understanding of conservation and sustainability. By integrating local and global dialogues with experiential learning, the initiative cultivates leadership, critical thinking, and collaborative inquiry, equipping future educators to implement impactful ESD curricula and advocate for sustainable development.




