Echoing CityUHK's mission to nurture and develop students' talents for social and economic advancement, the CityUHK Tiger Programme aims to transform elite students into future global leaders. Targeting high-achieving undergraduate students, known as Tigers, the programme boasts over 1,000 members in 2024/25. Its vision is to develop these high achievers, unite them, and co-create positive impacts on themselves, their peers, the school, and the community.



#### Tiger Development Series

This series offers online and offline activities including workshops, talks, visits, and forums to foster a growth mindset and to expand intellectual horizon. It addresses unique needs of elites like time management and personal branding, preaching industry and academic trends through interactions with eminent scholars and speakers.

#### **Tiger Coaching Sessions**

Given that elite students possess diverse talents and their pathways to success vary, we provide individualised coaching support service to Tigers. Tigers work across a coaching model with our master coach, leading to strength discovery, opportunity identification, goal refinement, and action plan formulation, turning ambitious goals into tangible achievements.

#### The Tiger House System

Embracing healthy competition, collaboration, and value co-creation, we are building a house environment to transcend Tigers from individual performance to group excellence. Tigers are required to strategize house activities to enable their own members to achieve extraordinary results in academics, mentorship, internships, and exchanges.





#### Tiger Crash Courses 101

Tiger mentors, who are experts in their respective fields, run courses for their fellow Tigers. It promotes interdisciplinary knowledge exchange and encourages thinking from learners' perspectives. Mentors must apply critical thinking skills to determine course objectives, design syllabi, and refine their delivery skills to communicate complex ideas to talents from different fields. These skills are crucial for their future careers as emerging leaders and subject matter experts.

#### Tiger x PALSI Leaders

The Peer-Assisted Learning Scheme using Supplemental Instruction is a university-wide initiative to assist all university students in the realms of learning to learn. Senior Tigers who have excelled in core courses guided junior students by discussing and sharing effective learning strategies. This initiative supports 788 students across 16 departments from 7 colleges and schools, offering 126 sessions from 33 different courses in 2024/25.
